OUTREACH: VOLUNTEERS IN MEDICINE (VIM)

Volunteers in Medicine-Hilton Head provides free medical and dental care for working poor families through the donated services of 500+ volunteers. The dental clinic needs help to provide dentures for patients with missing teeth. Although our dentists are volunteers, the lab work has to be outsourced and we must rely on donations to cover the lab bills.

The wait time for a denture is now 4-6 months. That is a long time to go without teeth, and the patient's ability to eat, smile and be employed is severely affected. The impact of a restored smile can be huge for these patients, improving both their economic and physical health. Many say their improved appearance has helped them get better jobs, often at higher wages.

A budget is not available for special needs like the denture program. Therefore, VIM is asking St. Luke's members to help us bring brighter smiles to more of our patients.
