Beginnings of Campus Work

Praise God! As a result of your prayers and generous financial support, I began working on campus this month! God blessed me in tremendous ways as I focused solely on fundraising and building ministry partners over the past several months. I had a goal of reaching 70% of my funding by the end of October, but in reality I reached that goal within the first week of October. At 70% funding, InterVarsity staff are able to begin part-time work on campus until they are fully funded. I am currently 81% funded and hope to be fully funded by the end of December.

In order to help jump start my ministry on campus, last Tuesday, October 21st, I taught at the Purdue InterVarsity undergraduate chapter's weekly large group Bible study, which we call "Dig-In". As I looked at the tables of students around the room, I was blown away by the level of diversity I saw. During my time as a student in Purdue InterVarsity, diversity was something with which we consistently struggled. However, as I looked around the room I saw men and women, and students from different ethnicities, different majors, and different countries. In that moment, it was clear to me that my prayers were being answered and God had really begun to lay the groundwork for starting something big with InterVarsity at Purdue, which I believe to be International Student Ministry. I am amazed and overwhelmed when I see the incredible work God has done through my InterVarsity position thus far. He

The hope is that in the long term, this small group would eventually be able to break off and plant our own InterVarsity group focused on reaching the international students of Purdue.
